Story Page Clues:

- ❖ Start at the bulletin board. Turn right and walk towards the water's edge. Turn right again. The lake is on the left and the parking area is on the right.
- ❖ Walk on the grass towards the woods. You will go past the back of the portable toilet (enclosed in a wooden fence on the right) and a wooden bench with a roof (on the left).
- ❖ Look for the entrance to trail 6 and follow it to the first intersection. At the Y intersection, turn right.
- ❖ Follow trail 6 as it goes uphill. Walk about 25 yards and when it levels out, turn right at the T intersection.
- ❖ You will begin going uphill again. The trail will bend to the right and to the left multiple times before reaching the very top.
- ❖ Once at the top, continue across the hilltop. At the Y intersection, turn right to continue on trail 6.
- ❖ Eventually you will come to another Y intersection. Turn slightly to the left and follow trail 6 straight.
- ❖ At the T intersection, turn left. At the next T intersection (where trail 6 intersects with trail 7), continue straight ahead on trail 6 as it goes uphill and bends to the left.
- ❖ The post can be found ahead in about 20 yards on the left.
- ❖ To return to the parking area, continue ahead on trail 6 until you reach the Y intersection. Turn right and follow trail 6 downhill. When the hill levels out, turn left at the T intersection. Continue going downhill and at the Y intersection, turn left. Follow trail 6 out of the woods and to the parking area.
