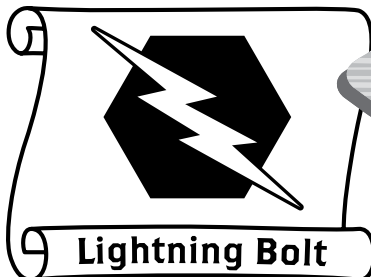

## Story Page Clues:

To receive the rubbing plate, you must correctly complete all blanks below and share them with the children's library staff during open library hours.

- ❖ From the front/main library steps, turn right and walk with E. Market St. on the left. Cross N. Duke and N. George Streets. What are the tops of the three tables made out of in front of i-ron-ic<sup>2</sup>? \_\_\_\_\_
- ❖ Continue to the traffic light pole at N. Beaver St. There is a box on the traffic light pole. What two words does it say on the left side of the box? \_\_\_\_\_
- ❖ Cross N. Beaver St. Look for the blue mural on the right after the 127 W. Market Street sign. These are The \_\_\_\_\_ Chaplains. Turn around and walk over to the York County 250th Anniversary mural. There is a silver plate under the mural on the right side. When did York separate from Lancaster County? \_\_\_\_\_
- ❖ Return to the sidewalk and turn left. At N. Beaver St., turn left. On the mural on the right side of the building at 38 N. Beaver St., what year was Central Market built? \_\_\_\_\_
- ❖ Go back to the sidewalk and turn left. Turn right at W. Phila. St. and cross N. Beaver St. Continue on and cross Cherry Lane. At N. George St., turn left and cross W. Phila St. On this block, what is around the bottom of the trees on the right? \_\_\_\_\_
- ❖ Continue straight. Look for the wooden gear statue on the right. What name is on the bottom of the statue (as you stand looking toward the street)? \_\_\_\_\_
- ❖ Continue straight. What color is the large, metal animal that is in the feline family on the right? \_\_\_\_\_
- ❖ Continue straight. At North St., turn right and cross N. George St. Turn right onto the sidewalk. N. George St. is now on the right.
- ❖ On the right side at 231 N. George St., what tool is the dragon's tongue? \_\_\_\_\_
- ❖ On the left, what color is the bird that is sitting on top of the brick pillar at the Wagman visitors parking lot? \_\_\_\_\_
- ❖ Cross the parking lot entrance. At the next parking lot on the left, carefully walk over to the mural on the brick building. This is a picture of the \_\_\_\_\_ printing press west of the Susquehanna River.
- ❖ Go back to the sidewalk and turn left. Cross over two crosswalks. What large animal is on the right side after the second crosswalk? \_\_\_\_\_
- ❖ At the corner of E. Philadelphia St., what animal is above the yellow crosswalk box watching the intersection? \_\_\_\_\_
- ❖ Cross E. Philadelphia St. There are \_\_\_\_\_ flagpoles outside the York County Judicial Center (on the left). Continue straight.
- ❖ At E. Market St., turn left. Cross N. Duke St. At N. Queen St., turn left. The post is located on the bike rack near the entrance to the children's library..
